The film was remade in Hindi as "Gunday" by director Rajkumar Santoshi and also by Sajid Khan for his directorial debut starring Salman Khan, Arbaaz Khan and Anushka Sharma. It was released worldwide on 23 March 2013, to mixed reviews. The Movie opened to massive collections and became highest grossing Bollywood movie of all time with its collection till date. On 23 March 2017, Suriya's Free-Spirit film "Thupakki" grossed more than the profit of the highest grossing Tamil movie Singam.

The songs are composed by D. Imman and lyrics are penned by Na. Muthukumar, Antara Bhat (Padhu Naalai). The music was released on Mango Music Company. All songs were performed by Vairamuthu with lyrics by Na. Muthukumar, Kabilan and D Imman, except "Ayyappa Kanden Song" sung by Ilayaraja The official soundtrack of the film has 6 songs which also includes two instrumental tracks.
